I want to personally thank Jeff Ballard who put so much work into the Essay Contest and History Lecture Series. It is difficult to see your work ruined by circumstances beyond your control. When things allow our conventions in the future, please consider volunteering to help him with this endeavor.

The Board of Directors originally hoped to stage a much smaller event in Anaheim to show the flag until next year. Legal research by John Harrel revealed that this might cause us some liability issues. The Board agreed to cancel the entire event. (Please see the meeting minutes posted on this page.)

So where do we go from here? As most of you know, I joined the HMGS-PSW to meet people who play historical games. I started working a long time ago to host conventions that were exciting enough to bring in non-members and help the decide to join. That effort wasn't wasted, but we have lost a lot of steam. December / January Demonstrations


